P 4638 Flooding at Horley Row and Orchard Close

It was noted that reported flooding problems at Horley Row, arising from a blocked drain, had been raised at a subsequent Police Panel meeting with Borough and County Council Representatives in attendance. The matter had been raised by Cllr Chapman on behalf of the resident concerned, who was unable to attend the meeting.

P 4639 Outdoor Seating Areas – Horley Precinct
